Drop the ending and add:

-ar

Tu: -a

Él/Ella/Ud: -e

Ellos/Ustedes: -en

Usar

Tu: usa

Él/Ella/Ud: use

Ellos/Ustedes: usen

-er

Tu: -e

Él/Ud: -a

Ellos/Uds: -an

Comer

Tu: come

Él/Ella/Ud: coma

Ellos/Ustedes: coman

-ir (vivir)

Tu: -e

Él/Ud: -a

Ellos/Uds: -an

Vivir

Tu: vive

Él/Ella/Ud: viva

Ellos/Ustedes: vivan

'Tu' Irregulars

- These verbs are irregular positive 'tu' commands:

decir: di

ser: sé

hacer: haz

tener: ten

poner: pon

venir: ven

ir: ve

salir: sal

Examples:

decir(to say): Di algo.

hacer(to do): Haz algo.

ir(to go): Ve a clase.

poner(to put): Pon esto allí.

tener(to have): ¡Ten buen día!

venir(to come): Ven conmigo

salir(to leave): Sal afuera.

ser(to be): Sé honesto.

- Name a hero of yours. How does his or her heroics compare to those of Cususa/Joaquin?
- Do you think Joaquin/Cususa is a hero?
- Imagine you are Joaquin in the midst of the battle with the Central American Federation army, here to pull your beloved Costa Rica under the rule of a central government. Your captain orders you to put out the fires, pump water from the leaking ship, beware flying bullets and help him up when he falls down. Conjugate the commands the captain gives you:
 - ¡Apagar el fuego!
 - ¡Bombear el agua del barco!
 - ¡Cuidar de que no estuvo herido!
 - ¡Ayudar me!
 - (Bonus): Tener cuidado!
